

**AFFIDAVIT FOR LATE VOTER REGISTRATION BY AN ABSENT

I affirm the following:

1. I am (**check only one item**)

5. I have completed the West Virginia voter registration application.

7. I will vote a provisional ballot which will be counted at canvass unless it is determined that I failed to meet the eligibility requirements for voter registration.
